BE TERREDUMND CERTIFIED, that heretofore on MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS The 30th day of October, 1997, said cause entitled to-wit: as hereinabove set forth, came on for hearing before the Madison County Grand Jury, at the Courthouse, in the City of Edwardsville, Madison County, Illinois. WHEREUPON the following proceedings were held of record, to-wit: COURT CONVENED: November 7th, 1996. \*\*\*\* (Witness Was sworn.) MICHAEL HOOKS called as a witness herein, having been duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows: DIRECT EXAMINATION BY MRS. JENSEN: Could you state your name, please? MRS. Q. Okay. The grand jury is investigating the death
of Nekemar Pearson. Did you know him?
A. Yes, I did.
Q. And are you familiar with any of the
circumstances surrounding his disappearance or the last time
he was seen?
A. Somewhat.
Q. Okay. Directing your attention to the summer of
1995, did you have occasion to come upon an incident
involving Mr. Pearson and some other men?
A. Yes, I did.
Q. Okay. Could you tell us about when that was,
and what time of the day?

9	A. I think his name is James, but they call him
10	something else. He go by another name him.

12	A. He lives on Powahattan.
13	Q. And what kind of a house, can you describe his
14	house?
15	A. I don't know for sure if he stays, I know his
16	mother's house. His mother's house has got a fence, red
17	house.
18	Q. It is a red house?
19	A. Yes, with a fence.
20	Q. In reference to where this fight was going on,
21	where was his mother's house?
22	A. Right there, it was, they was fighting in between
23	two houses, between his mother's house and another house.
