

1 Bond in the meantime will remain in full force and  
2 effect, and the Defendant will be remanded back to the  
3 custody of the Madison County Sheriff. When I say bond  
4 remains in full force and effect, that is no bond.

5 Now, Mr. Evans, I want you to please understand,  
6 sir, that should you fail to appear at your trial or any part  
7 thereof, that is you are absent, that you could be tried, you  
8 could be convicted, you could even be sentenced if you fail  
9 to appear. Do you understand, sir?

10 DEFENDANT EVANS: Yes, sir.

11 THE COURT: Thank you, Mr. Evans. Anything further  
12 from Mr. Keith Jensen?

13 MR. JENSEN: Your Honor, I believe we have a Motion  
14 for Discovery in the murder case, and I would ask that  
15 include handwriting and hair samples from the Defendant.

16 THE COURT: Mr. Shaw, do you have any problem with  
17 that?

18 MR. SHAW: No, I am afraid they are entitled to it.

19 THE COURT: You stand absolutely correct from the  
20 record, sir. You draw up the appropriate Order.

21 MR. JENSEN: I would also move that we be allowed  
22 to x-ray his hand.

23 MR. SHAW: What for?

24 MR. JENSEN: He made complaints that he hurt his

1 hand when he killed Nekemar Pearson and he broke it.

2 MR. SHAW: Well, you will have -- we are not going  
3 to agree to that.

4 THE COURT: So that will have to be subject to a  
5 formal Motion then, Mr. Jensen. I am going to correct the  
6 record that this case 634 is assigned to Judge Keshner as  
7 well as the 2131. In other words both cases are assigned to  
8 this Court.

9 MR. SHAW: Judge, we will let him go ahead and  
10 x-ray.

11 THE COURT: Take the x-ray. Mr. Jensen, propose an  
12 Order. Anything further, Mr. Shaw?

13 MR. SHAW: No, sir.

14 THE COURT: All right. Gentlemen, the telephones  
15 work much quicker and easier than cutting down trees and  
16 papering the Court. So if you have some problems with any of  
17 these settings or anything as we did setting this Preliminary  
18 Hearing, save yourself some time and money and call me.  
19 Okay, Mr. Jensen?

20 MR. JENSEN: Thank you, your Honor.

21 THE COURT: Okay, Mr. Shaw?

22 MR. SHAW: (Nodding affirmatively.)

23 THE COURT: Thank you, gentlemen.
