BE IT REMEMBERED AND CERTIFIED, that heretofore on to-wit: The 21st day of January, 1999, said cause entitled as hereinabove set forth, came on for hearing before the Honorable Charles Romani, Jr., at the Courthouse, in the City of Edwardsville, Madison County, Illinois.

WHEREUPON the following proceedings were held of record, to-wit:

COURT CONVENED: January 21st, 1999.

THE COURT: This cause before the Court, People of the State of Illinois Vs. Clifton Wheeler, #96-CF-2297.

People present by Assistant State's Attorney, Keith Jensen. Mr. Wheeler is present with his attorney, Ben Allen.

This matter comes before the Court for change of plea pursuant to negotiations.

MR. ALLEN: Your Honor, I think I will defer to Mr. Jensen, I will accede to his comments.

THE COURT: Okay.

MR. JENSEN: Your Honor, at this time there have been negotiations which would include, the defendant would plead guilty to the charge of murder. The State and the defendant would agree to a sentence of twenty-three years, to be served in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

That in addition to that, the defendant is agreeing to cooperate and testify when requested in the prosecution of anyone else involved in the death of Dwight Riddlespriger, including Jeffrey Ewing. And the defendant will further cooperate in the investigation in the death involving Nekemar Pearson.

The Court, we would ask the Court to retain jurisdiction over this matter. And at any time, if any of the other people are sentenced to the penitentiary, we would then ask the Court to enter an Order that Mr. Wheeler not be placed in the same penitentiary as any of the people that he testifies or cooperates against.

That is basically the negotiations, Your Honor.

THE COURT: Mr. Allen?

MR. ALLEN: That's correct, Your Honor.

THE COURT: Okay, Mr. Wheeler, is that your

understanding of your negotiations?

MR. ALLEN: It is my understanding, off the record.
