  - A. We left Reliable after getting the speakers

installed in the car, we left and I went home. That was on Powhattan.

- Q. Is this three doors down from Raven?
- A. Correct.
- Q. Okay.

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- A. I seen Raven and he said, man, I heard that Skeeter pulling out my speakers. I said, yeah, what about it? He was like I don't want them back or nothing. I just want to know who sold it to him. I said, why? I mean, what's the big deal?
