
07-03-95 MONDAY 1800 HRS

I, Detective Cooley, was north bound in the 900 block of west 9th street on July 3rd, 1995 at approximately 1700 to 1800 hours. I observed Nekemar Pearson walking south bound on the west side of West 9th Street. Pearson was walking with another black male youth. Pearson stared at Reporting officer as I drove past him. The other youth was smaller than Pearson and appeared to be younger. I did not recognize the second youth.


I have had several prior contacts with Pearson due to Pearson being a student at Alton High School and I have been the school liaison officer with the Alton school district for the last two years.

I was not aware that Pearson had been reported as a missing pearson, until later this date.
