PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR DISCOVERY  
IN POST-CONVICTION RELIEF PROCEEDINGS

NOW COMES, THE Petitioner, James Evans, through and by his attorney, and respectfully moves this Honorable Court pursuant to 725 ILCS 5/122-1, of the Post-Conviction Hearing Act, in Good Cause, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 412, to order the State Prosecution to tender to the defense in this Collateral Relief Proceedings the following Discovery material and documents thereof:

In Support thereof, the Petitioner states as follows:

1. The Petitioner is currently incarcerated at the Menard Correctional Center in Menard, Illinois 62259.
2. The Petitioner was found guilty by jury for Murder, Solicitation of Murder before the Honorable Judge James Hackett, presiding judge on August 13, 1999 and November 12, 1999.
3. In which the petitioner is now serving a sentence of 107 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections.
4. That he is an indigent person within the statute and believes he has a meritorious cause for review before this court.

5. The Petitioner requests original audio tapes, People's Exhibit #34, Defendant's Exhibit C, and Common Law Records pertaining to case at bar.
6. These original audio tapes and Common Law Records is evidence that proves the Prosecution, in the above case, knowingly committed a discovery violation pertaining to these tapes introduced against the Petitioner; as well as the audio tapes in the State's possession, that was not introduced at trial.
7. The Petitioner requests the make and model number of all recording devices used to overhear or eavesdropping/telephone overhear material.
8. The Petitioner additionally requests the State tender to the defense all police reports pertaining to the above case, for the reason that the trial counsel withheld and failed to disclose all of the State's discovery to the Petitioner, which would be necessary to raise the issue of ineffective assistance of counsel.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully request and prays that this Honorable Court grant the Petitioner's Request for Discovery in Post-Conviction Relief Proceedings.
