As soon as I got out the front door, I heard one gunshot. I am positive that I am the first one out, because I left so quickly. It seems like BOSS or somebody else got out after me. The gunman was still inside, so I ran down to the payphone at the gas station at 9th and Belle Street.

*R.A.* I was calling my Aunt LENNY LOVE, to go get my Aunt GWENDOLYN, who lives at 2114 Amelia. *(GOC) GWENDOLYN DON'T HAVE A PHONE BUT THEY ARE NEIGHBORS. (GOC) R.A.* I was waiting for someone to answer the phone when I heard another shot. Once

LENNY answered the phone, I told her that the place was being robbed and to get GWENDOLYN down to me fast. While I was awaiting for my aunt, a lot of other people were running out of the building. I noticed that a few stood around the front of the building, but I couldn't figure out why they were just standing around when there had been shooting. I didn't know that anybody got shot and I didn't know that KENNY had even been hurt. KENNY was still inside with the dude when I ran out.

*ABOUT FIVE MINUTES TO COME (GOC) R.A.* It had only taken Aunt GWENDOLYN ~~to get~~ to me. She had drove on W. 9th Street to pick me up and we left the same way she came in, so we didn't even go back by the Chess Club. When we left there was no ambulance or police even around.

Like I said earlier, the dude that had the gun did have a mask on, but, I had been by VALDEZ almost all the time that he was playing dice. The dude looked to have the same height and weight and same clothing that VALDEZ had on earlier, but when the dude spoke, I knew that it was VALDEZ' voice.
